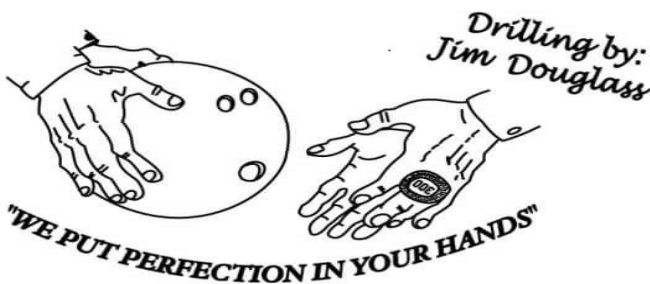

ADULT / YOUTH TOURNAMENT RULES

1. ELIGIBILITY:

All bowlers must be USBC Sanctioned Members.

2. ENTRY FEE:

\$35.00 per Bowler. Prize Fund: \$21.00, Lineage: \$12.00, Expenses: \$2.00 Per Bowler
Prepaid Per Bowler. Prize Fund: \$16.00, Lineage: \$12.00, Expenses: \$2.00 per Bowler

3. AVERAGES:

A. Youth advisors must provide a current standing sheet with proof of average, within 1 week of tournament.

B. Youth Bowlers Current 2024 – 2025 average will be used (minimum of twelve games).

C. If the Youth Bowler does not have a 2024 – 2025 average, the highest 2023 - 2024 average (minimum of 21 games) will be used.

D. Adult Bowlers will use highest 2023-2024 avg. If no avg. exists bowler will use highest 2024-2025 avg min 21 Games.

E. If the bowler has no average, 230 will be used. Current High School standing sheets will be accepted as average verification.

F. USBC Rule 319a. 3. **"THE TEN PIN RULE"** Each bowler is responsible for verifying his/her own average, whether submitted by the bowler, or guardian. If the submitted average is lower than required and results in a lower classification or more handicap, the bowler's score is disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average. In the case of a team of two or more bowlers, the averages will be combined to determine if the correct total is higher or lower than the submitted total.

G. USBC Rule 319c. Prior to bowling, tournament management may assign a higher average (re-rate) when information indicates the individual may be a better bowler. If this assigned average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fees shall be refunded.

H. Rule 319e. (15 pin tournament rule) is waived for this tournament.

4. SUBSTITUTES:

Any substitutes must meet the same eligibility requirements as the original entrant and must use the proper average as shown under rule 3. It is the bowler's responsibility to notify the tournament director when he or she is bowling as a replacement bowler.

5. HANDICAP:

Handicap is 90% of 460 average for the adult and youth bowlers Team.

6. PRIZE FUND:

All prize money collected will be returned 100% in the form of scholarships and placed in the USBC SMART program to the participants. Payout will be 1 in 5 Entries or based on the number of entries.

7. ATTIRE:

All bowlers are required to wear shirts, pants/shorts that are in good condition, not torn or with holes. Pants/Shorts must be worn at the waist. Skirts and shorts must be at least Fingertip length. Please note Rule 301b. All decisions on attire will be made by the tournament manager.

**No electronic devices, phones, iPods, etc. may be used during competition (unless used for medical reasons).
A score keeping APP is approved to use during competition.**

Bowlers are expected to practice bowling etiquette, one lane courtesy and GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP!

Anything that is not covered by the tournament rules listed above will be covered by USBC Rules.

All decisions by Tournament Management are FINAL, unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
