YOUTH NO-TAP TOURNAMENT RULES

1. ELIGIBILITY: All Bowlers must be sanctioned with Suburban South Jersey USBC.
2. ENTRY FEE:
 - A. \$35.00 Per Bowler. (Pre-Registered) Prize Fund: \$21.00, Lineage: \$12.00, Expenses: \$2.00
 - B. \$40.00 Per Bowler. Prize Fund: \$26.00, Lineage: \$12.00, Expenses: \$2.00
3. AVERAGES:
 - A. Youth advisors must provide a current standing sheet, with proof of average, within 1 week of tournament.
 - B. Current 2026 – 2027 average will be used (minimum of 9 games)
 - C. If the bowler does not have a 2026 – 2027 average, the highest 2025 – 2026 average (minimum of 21 games) will be used.
 - D. If the bowler has no average, 230 will be used. Current High School standing sheets will be accepted as average verification.
 - E. USBC Rule 319a. 3. Each bowler is responsible for verifying his/her own average, whether submitted by the bowler, or guardian. If the submitted average is lower than required and results in a lower classification or more handicap, the bowler's score will be disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average. In the case of a team of two or more bowlers, the averages will be combined to determine if the correct total is higher or lower than the submitted total.
 - F. USBC Rule 319c. Prior to bowling, tournament management may assign a higher average (re-rate) when information indicates the individual may be a better bowler. If this assigned average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fees shall be refunded.
 - G. Rule 319e. (15 pin tournament rule) is waived for this tournament.
4. DIVISIONS: Based on average and are as follows:
 - A. Division 1: 0-130
 - B. Division 2: 131-180
 - C. Division 3: 181+
5. HANDICAP: Handicap is 90% based on 230.
6. PRIZE MONEY: All Prize money collected for each event and each division will be returned 100% in the form of scholarships and placed in the USBC SMART program. Payouts will be 1 in 5 entries or based on the number of entries in that event or division.
7. ATTIRE: All bowlers are required to wear shirts, pants/shorts that are in good condition, not torn or with holes. Pants/shorts must be worn at the waist. Skorts and shorts must be at least fingertip length. Please note Rule 301b. All decisions on the attire will be made by the Tournament Manager.

No electronic devices, phones, iPods, etc. may be used during competition (unless used for medical reasons). A score keeping APP is approved to use during competition.

Bowlers are expected to practice bowling etiquette, one lane courtesy and GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP!

All decisions by the Tournament Management are FINAL, unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329. Anything that is not covered by the tournament rules listed above will be covered by USBC Rules
